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COUNT ONE

Conspiracy to receive, transport and deal in firearms, and to transport firearms into state of residency in violation of 18 U.S.C. §922(a)(1) & 922(a)(3)

1. Beginning on a date unknown, but not later than December 2008, and continuing through on or about June 13, 2009, in the State and Federal District of Nevada and elsewhere within the jurisdiction of this Court,

1. JONNATAN WEISS, and 2. WILLIAM WEISS,

the defendants herein, while not being licensed dealers of firearms within the meaning of Chapter 44, Title 18, United States Code, knowingly and willfully combined, conspired, and agreed with one another, and others to known and unknown to commit offenses against the United States in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(a), that is:

- (a) to engage in the business of dealing in firearms, and to receive and transport firearms in interstate or foreign commerce for purposes of engaging in the business of dealing in firearms in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(a)(1); and
- (b) to transport firearms which defendant WILLIAM WEISS purchased in Nevada into California, the State in which WILLIAM WEISS resides, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(a)(3).
- 2. JONNATAN WEISS, WILLIAM WEISS, and others known and unknown conspired and combined for the common objectives of engaging in the business of dealing in firearms, receiving and transporting firearms in interstate or foreign commerce for purposes of engaging in such a business. One or more of the conspirators took substantial steps towards these ends. For example, the defendants committed the following overt acts in furtherance of the conspiracy:.
 - (a) On several occasions during the period from December 2008 to June 2009, JONNATAN WEISS, WILLIAM WEISS and other conspirators traveled from Mexico and California to Nevada for purposes of obtaining and purchasing firearm to resell to others.

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- (b) In furtherance of the conspiracy, in December 2008, JONNATAN WEISS, WILLIAM WEISS and another conspirator fraudulently obtained a Nevada drivers' license and a Nevada identification card falsely purporting that they each resided at 4037 Rustic Oak Court, North Las Vegas, Nevada. In truth, the defendants did not reside at that address nor in Nevada, but instead resided in California and Mexico.
- (c) Posing as Nevada residents, the conspirators used the fraudulently obtained Nevada identification documents to circumvent restrictions on the sale of firearms to nonresidents.
- (d) During the span from December, 2008, through June 13, 2009, the conspirators received, and attempted to acquire, multiple firearms and firearm components in Nevada which had been manufactured elsewhere and transported in interstate or foreign commerce. As part of and in furtherance of the conspiracy, JONNATAN WEISS and WILLIAM WEISS purchased and attempted to purchase an array of semi-automatic pistols, tactical pistols and tactical rifles including:
 - (i) a Kimber "Pro TLE II" .45 caliber pistol.
 - (ii) a Beretta "90-Two".40 caliber pistol;
 - (iii) an STI (Strayer Tripp International) "2011 Tactical" 9 millimeter pistol;
 - (iv) a Rock Island Armory "1911" .45 caliber pistol;
 - (v) a Colt "Combat Elite".45 caliber pistol;
