## Attachment A

On August 30, 2013, U.S. Alcohol, Tobacco & Firearms (ATF) Special Agents conducted an interview of Francisco Javier GARCIA after they received information alleging GARCIA had recently purchased three firearms at a local gun show in McAllen, Texas. ATF conducts regulatory inspections of allegations involving identified convicted felon. GARCIA admitted to purchasing an AR-15, two handguns. GARCIA forfeited two firearms to ATF Special Agents. The weapons were described as an AR-15 rifle and a .45 caliber pistol. Queries conducted of the AR-15 and .45 caliber pistol, it was determined they were manufactured outside the State of Texas. ATF Special Agent was contacted and he continued he conducted the queries and the results of the queries. SA Rangel is considered an expert. GARCIA stated he attended a local gun show in McAllen, Texas with intentions of purchasing several weapons. While at the gun show, GARCIA purchased an AR-15 assault type weapon for \$800.00 USD from a vendor. GARCIA stated he presented his identification to the vendor as was able to purchase the AR-15 rifle. GARCIA stated he visited another vendor and was denied the sale of a weapon upon his records check by the vendor. GARCIA stated he returned to the previous vendor and bought two additional handguns being a .40 & .45 caliber pistols. GARCIA stated he purchased each handgun for \$225.00 USD. GARCIA stated he knew there was a problem when the second vendor denied him the sale of a weapon but still decided to purchase two more guns.

On August 21, 2013, before the 389<sup>th</sup> District Court in Hidalgo County, GARCIA was convicted for Possession of Marijuana and sentenced to five (5) years probation, which will expire on August 21, 2018.
