INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT ONE

On or about March 27, 2014, in the Houston Division of the Southern District of Texas,

**ROSENDO PADILLA JR.**

defendant herein, having been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year did knowingly possess in and affecting commerce a firearm, to wit, one or more of the following: two Bushmaster, Model XM15, .223 Caliber Rifles, two Romarm, Model WASR10 7.62 Caliber Rifles, two Century Arms, Model 1960 7.62 Caliber Rifles, one Century Arms, Model M70B1Sporter 7.62 Caliber Rifle, which had been shipped in interstate and foreign commerce.


In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2)
