SUPERSEDING INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

Count One

From on or about January 25, 2011, to on or about May 9, 2011, in the Southern District of Texas and within the jurisdiction of the Court, defendants,

FELIX TORRES and VIVIANA MENDOZA

knowingly made, and aided and abetted the making of a false statement and representation with respect to information required to be kept in the records of Erick Ford Kruger d/b/a The Armory, McAllen, Texas, a federally licensed firearms dealer, in connection with the acquisition of an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09127290; an Arsenal, Model SGL21-16, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09125927; a Century International Arms, Model M70AB, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AB206407; an Arsenal, Model SGL21-61, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09128734; and an Arsenal Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial numberL09128967, in that defendant FELIX TORRES, aided and abetted defendant VIVIANA MENDOZA, who falsely represented

on the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms Form 4473, that VIVIANA MENDOZA was the actual buyer of the firearms described above, when in truth and fact the defendants knew that those statements and representations were false and that VIVIANA MENDOZA was not the actual buyer of the firearms.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 924(a)(1)(A) and 2.

Count Two

From on or about October 5, 2010, to on or about March 7, 2011, in the Southern District of Texas and within the jurisdiction of the Court, defendants,

FELIX TORRES and NOE RAYMOND TORRES also known as Noe Torres

knowingly made, and aided and abetted the making of a false statement and representation with respect to information required to be kept in the records of Erick Ford Kruger d/b/a The Armory, McAllen, Texas, a federally licensed firearms dealer, in connection with the acquisition of a Century International Arms, Model WASR 10, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AH72081989; a Century International Arms, Model M70AB2T, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AB2T-N102274; a Century International Arms, Model M70AB2, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AB2T-N102190; an Arsenal, Model Legion, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09127384; a Century International Arms, Model AKMS, 7.62mm rifle, serial number KMS00865; and a Century International Arms, Model M70AB2, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AB204347, in that defendant FELIX TORRES, aided and abetted defendant NOE RAYMOND TORRES, who falsely represented on the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms Form 4473, that NOE RAYMOND TORRES was the actual buyer of the firearms described above, when in truth and fact the defendants knew that those statements and representations were false and that NOE RAYMOND TORRES was not the actual buyer of the firearms.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 924(a)(1)(A) and 2.

Count Three

From on or about May 9, 2011, to on or about May 13, 2011, in the Southern District of Texas and within the jurisdiction of the Court, defendants,

FELIX TORRES
IZAHA SAENZ
and
ILMA GARCIA

knowingly made, and aided and abetted the making of a false statement and representation with respect to information required to be kept in the records of Erick Ford Kruger d/b/a The Armory, McAllen, Texas, a federally licensed firearms dealer, in connection with the acquisition of an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09129846; an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09129174; an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09129019; an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09129834, an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09128505; an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09128319; an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09128514; and an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09128522, in that defendants FELIX TORRES and IZAHA SAENZ, aided and abetted defendant ILMA GARCIA, who falsely represented on the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms Form 4473, that ILMA GARCIA was the actual buyer of the firearms described above, when in truth and fact the defendants knew that those statements and representations were false and that ILMA GARCIA was not the actual buyer of the firearms.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 924(a)(1)(A) and 2.

Count Four

From on or about November 29, 2010, to on or about May 10, 2011, in the Southern District of Texas and within the jurisdiction of the Court, defendants,

FELIX TORRES and BARBARA GARFIAS

knowingly made, and aided and abetted the making of a false statement and representation with respect to information required to be kept in the records of Erick Ford Kruger d/b/a The Armory, McAllen, Texas, a federally licensed firearms dealer, in connection with the acquisition of a Arsenal, Model Saiga 308, .308 caliber rifle, serial number H09723987; a Century International Arms, Model M70AB2, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AB2T-N102674; an Arsenal, Model Saiga 308, .308 caliber rifle, serial number H09723627; a Century International Arms, Model AKMS, 7.62mm rifle, serial number KMS00968; an Arsenal, Model SGL21-61, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09126734; an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09129541; and an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09128503, in that defendant FELIX TORRES, aided and abetted defendant BARBARA GARFIAS, who falsely represented on the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms Form 4473, that BARBARA GARFIAS was the actual buyer of the firearms described above, when in truth and fact the defendants knew that those statements and representations were false and that BARBARA GARFIAS was not the actual buyer of the firearms.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 924(a)(1)(A) and 2.

Count Five

From on or about October 20, 2010, to on or about April 29, 2011, in the Southern District of Texas and within the jurisdiction of the Court, defendants,

FELIX TORRES and JUAN ANTONIO PEREZ, II

knowingly made, and aided and abetted the making of a false statement and representation with respect to information required to be kept in the records of Erick Ford Kruger d/b/a The Armory, McAllen, Texas, a federally licensed firearms dealer, in connection with the acquisition of a Century International Arms, WASR 10, 7.62mm rifle, serial number 1966RS2118; a Century International

Arms, Model M70AB2, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AB2T-N101814; an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09126244; a Century International Arms, Model M70AB2, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AB205212; and an Arsenal, Model SGL21-61, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09129842, in that defendant FELIX TORRES, aided and abetted defendant JUAN ANTONIO PEREZ, II, who falsely represented on the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms Form 4473, that JUAN ANTONIO PEREZ, II was the actual buyer of the firearms described above, when in truth and fact the defendants knew that those statements and representations were false and that JUAN ANTONIO PEREZ, II was not the actual buyer of the firearms.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 924(a)(1)(A) and 2.

Count Six

From on or about February 23, 2011, to on or about April 23, 2011, in the Southern District

FELIX TORRES and NAYELY RUBY HERRERA

knowingly made, and aided and abetted the making of a false statement and representation with respect to information required to be kept in the records of Erick Ford Kruger d/b/a The Armory, McAllen, Texas, a federally licensed firearms dealer, in connection with the acquisition of a Century International Arms, Model M70AB, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AB204962; an Arsenal, Model SGL21-61, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09129552; an Arsenal, Model Saiga, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09129176; and an Arsenal, Model SGL21-61, 7.62mm rifle, serial number L09129643; in that defendant FELIX TORRES, aided and abetted defendant NAYELY RUBY HERRERA, who falsely represented on the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms Form 4473, that NAYELY RUBY HERRERA was the actual buyer of the firearms described above, when in truth and fact the defendants knew that those statements and representations were false and that NAYELY RUBY HERRERA was not the actual buyer of the firearms.

Count Seven

On or about December 3, 2010, in the Southern District of Texas and within the jurisdiction

of the Court, defendant,

FELIX TORRES

previously having been convicted in the 92nd District Court, Hidalgo County, Texas, on June 6, 2005,

for the felony offense of burglary of habitation, in cause number CR-1648-05-A, a crime punishable

by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, did knowingly and unlawfully possess in and

affecting interstate and foreign commerce two firearms, namely, a Century International Arms,

Model M70AB2, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AB2T-N102601; and a Century International Arms,

Model M70AB2, 7.62mm rifle, serial number AB2T-N101276.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).
